To Submit an Assignment

- 1. Re-read the assignment
- 2. Zip project files
- 3. Create email addressed to <u>mbrooks@alpinedistrict.org</u>
- 4. Put your name AND assignment name in subject
- 5. Attach zip file

 - Right-click project
 - Select Open Folder in File Explorer

- Select all files EXCEPT *bin* and *obj* folders
- Right-click and select **Send to** -> **Compressed (zipped)**

- If email rejects your attachment you probably left the bin and/or obj folders in the zip file.
- Open zip file and delete bin and obj folders.
- Be sure to re-read the assignment before sending.
- Make sure you have everything covered.

- When updating code, REPLY to the previous email
